The excursion starts at the very impressive and historic Arkadi monastery, situated on a fertile plateau 23 km to the southeast of Rethymnon. The monastery is a historical symbol linked to the national pride of the Cretan people as it played a significant role in the Cretan revolt against Ottoman rule in 1866.

We then head to Eleftherna, a village of great natural beauty. The remnants of the ancient city of Eleftherna, one of the most important archaeological sites in Crete, lie near the modern village. A visit to the museum with an exhibition of the findings of ancient Eleftherna is a must.

Our next destination is the village of Margarites which is famous for its Minoan inspired pottery production. Strolling along the narrow streets of Margarites, you will see beautifully decorated doors and walls from the era of Venetian rule. The village gives a real sense of how Cretan villages used to be in past centuries.

ARGIROUPOLI SPRINGS GEORGIROUPOLIS LAKE OF KOURNAS

The next destination is Georgiroupoli, a seaside village which has become a modern tourist destination. Built in a beautiful area surrounded by lush greenery which the Almyros river runs through.

Our last stop is the wonderful Lake Kournas, the only natural freshwater lake on Crete. The lake is located at the foothills of the famous White Mountains and the southeast side is covered with olive groves.

Exploring inland Rethymnon heading towards the south coast, we reach the amazing Kourtaliotis gorge, one of the most spectacular natural attractions of Crete. Along its length, huge cliffs of limestone, reaching 500 meters in height, are full of caves, where many species of birds, especially raptors, nest, making the Kourtaliotis gorge an important biotope.

Further on we come to the historical orthodox Preveli Monastery which played a vital role in the revolts of the Cretan people against their occupiers. It is located on a gorgeous site with an amazing view to the Libyan Sea.

Our last visit is the popular tourist destination of Plakias with plenty of restaurants, cafes and bars along a stretch of the south coast. On our way back the village of Myrthios is the next destination where you can enjoy a breathtaking view of Plakias.

Then driving through the Kotsyfos Gorge, a place of spectacular wild beauty, and cross several traditional small villages until we reach back to Rethymnon.

KOURTALIOTIS GORGE • PREVELI MONASTERY • KALYPSO

Exploring the mainland of Rethymnon heading the southern coast until we reach the amazing Kourtaliotis gorge, one of the most spectacular natural attractions of Crete. The beach is surrounded by steep cliffs and is situated at the mouth of the Preveli River, which creates a beautiful palm forest, giving the place a tropical feel.

Arkadi Monastery is a historic Eastern Orthodox monastery situated on a fertile plateau 23km to the southeast of Rethymnon. It is renowned for its role in the Cretan resistance against Ottoman rule in 1866. The monastery has great significance in Greek history and is also known for its impressive architecture and beautiful surroundings. It is a popular destination for visitors interested in history and religious landmarks.

The next destination is the valley of Amari, a beautiful and historically significant area revealing the magnificent landscape of mountains, Agios Antonios gorge and a beautiful artificial lake.

You can then explore the Kourkoulos vineyards where visitors often praise the winery for its warm hospitality, informative tours, and exceptional wines. The winery specializes in indigenous Cretan grape varieties, producing six distinct wine labels from four native grapes.

White Wines: Vidiano, Vilana, and Moschato Spinis.

Rosé Wines: Crafted from red grapes with varying skin contact durations, offering unique flavor profiles.

Red Wines: Liatiko (also known as Ziatika), noted for its light color and dry character.

This excursion starts with the most important archeological site in Crete, the Minoan palace of Knossos, which is linked to thrilling legends, such as the myth of the Labyrinth and the Minotaur.

Afterwards we visit a Cretan Winery (15 minutes from Knossos Palace) where a guided tour begins with vineyards, cellars where wine is aged in oak barrels and a wine tasting of 6 wines made from the indigenous varieties of Crete.

Our final destination is the interesting Archaeological Museum of Heraklion. It houses representative artefacts from all the periods of Cretan prehistory and history covering a chronological span of over 5,500 years from the Neolithic period to Roman times.

PHAISTOS • GORTYNA CRETAN ETHNOLOGY MUSEUM (VORI)

Phaistos is a significant Minoan archaeological site located on a hill overlooking the fertile Messara Plain in south-central Crete. The site was inhabited from the Late Neolithic period through the Late Bronze Age, with the first settlements dating back to around 3000 BC. The ruins visible today primarily belong to the Neopalatial period. Unlike the reconstructed palace at Knossos, Phaistos has been preserved without extensive restoration, offering visitors a more authentic glimpse into Minoan architecture and urban planning.

The next destination is Gortyna, one of the most powerful cities in ancient Crete, especially during the Roman period, when it even served as the capital of the Roman province of Creta et Cyrenaica.

Our last stop is the museum of Cretan Ethnology in the village of Vori in southern Crete, approximately 2 km north of the ancient site of Phaistos. The museum offers a comprehensive exhibition of Cretan cultural and traditional life. In 1992, it was awarded the European Museum of the Year Award by the Council of Europe.

Driving east, along the north coast and enjoying the lovely view of the Cretan Sea, we reach the fishing village of Elounda. The “island of tears” Spinalonga located after a short cruise through the blue waters from Elounda. This island firstly was a stronghold of the Venetians, then inhabited by the Turks. Between 1903 and 1957 hundreds of Greece’s lepers were shipped here and then forbidden to leave. It is notable for being one of the last active leper colonies in Europe. You can take a walk around the remains of the colony. A chance for you to see it’s main street with the houses where the lepers attempted to live ordinary lives. It’s a place not to be missed!!

After the short cruise in Spinalonga returning back to Elounda, where you have free time. Then we’ll visit the Agios Nikolaos town, a city with unique features, start with the lake an especially picturesque site which is connected to the sea by a narrow inlet.

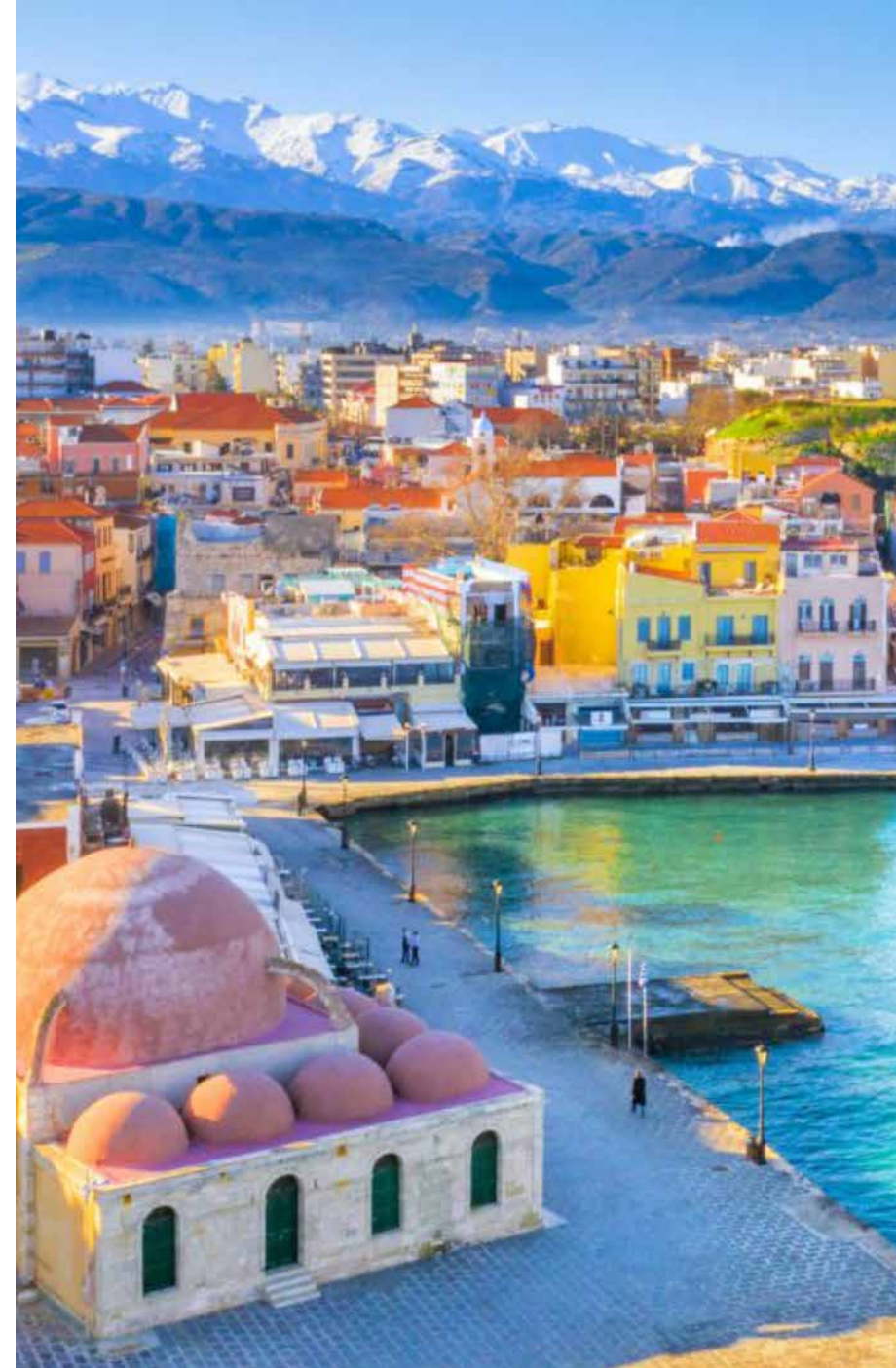

AGIA TRIADA • MONASTERY TSAGKAROLO • CHANIA TOWN

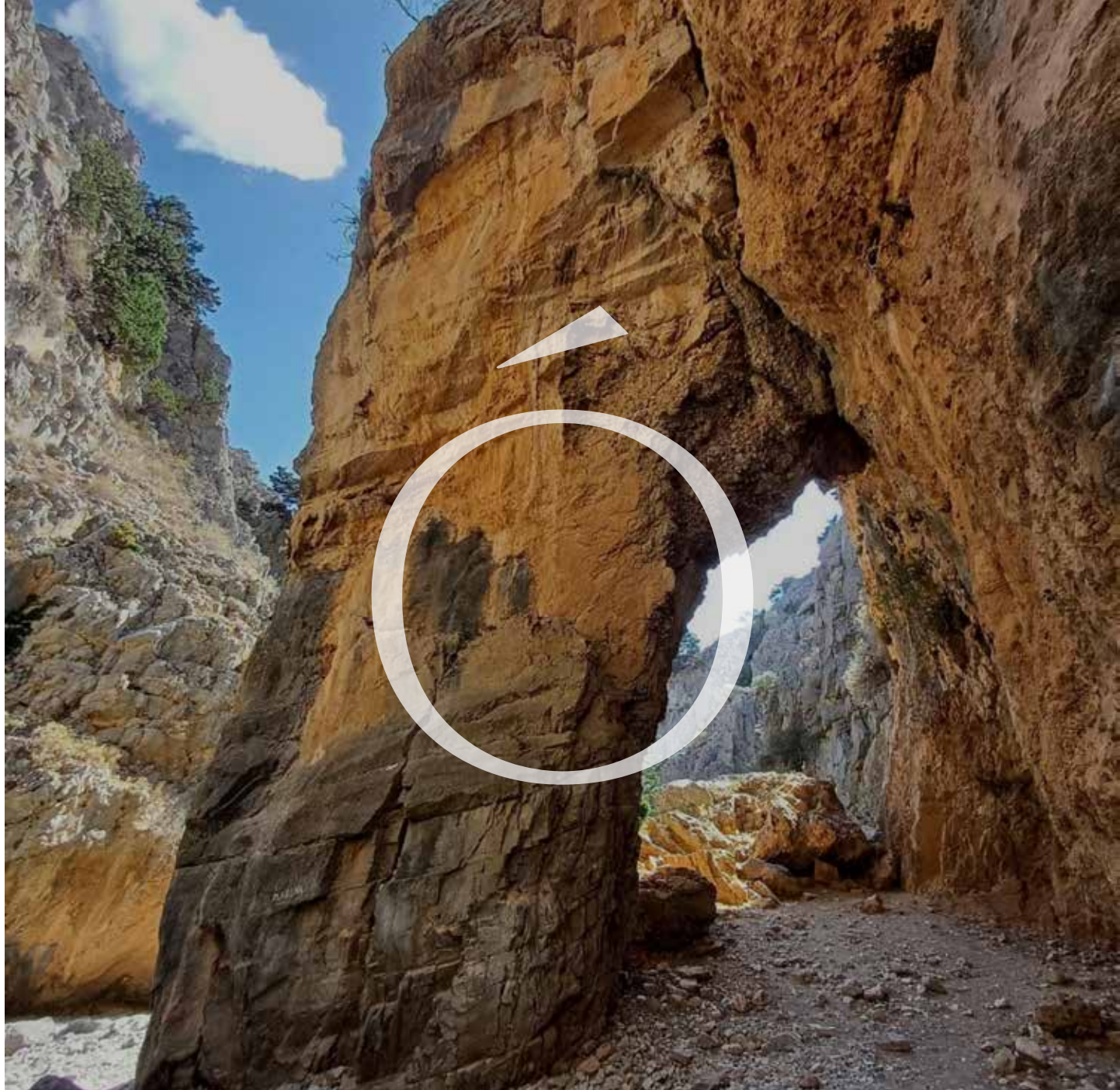
IMBROS GORGE

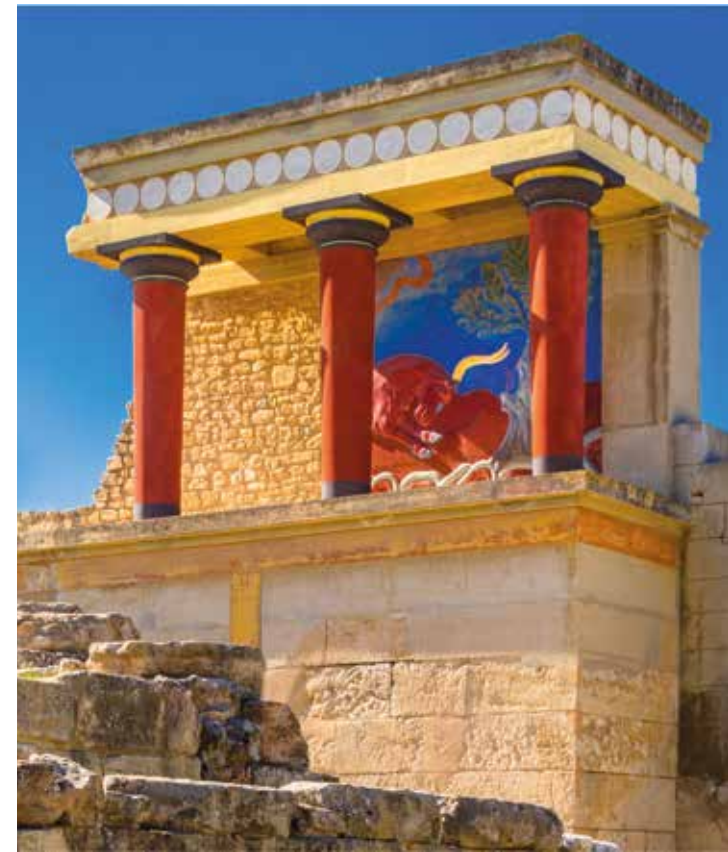
